Math:

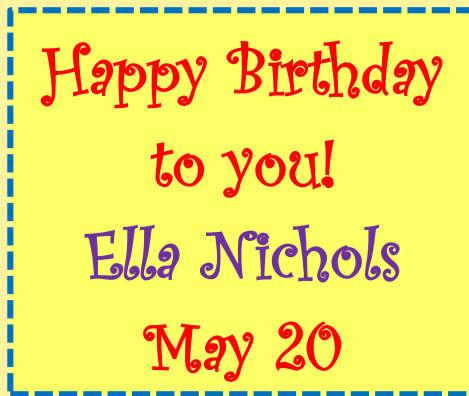
- Order fractions from least to greatest or greatest to least
